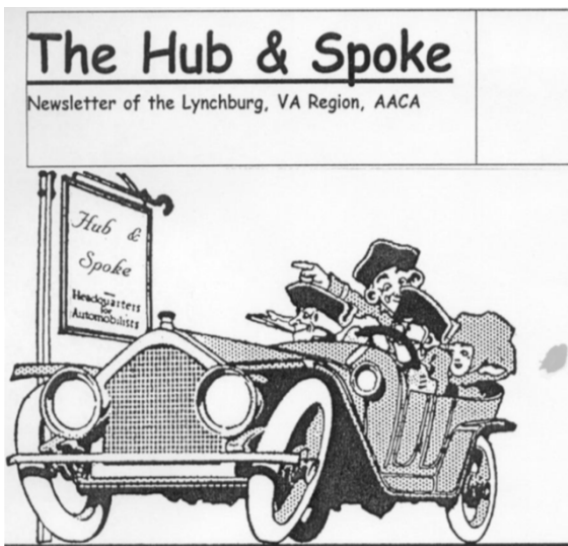


July Club Activities
