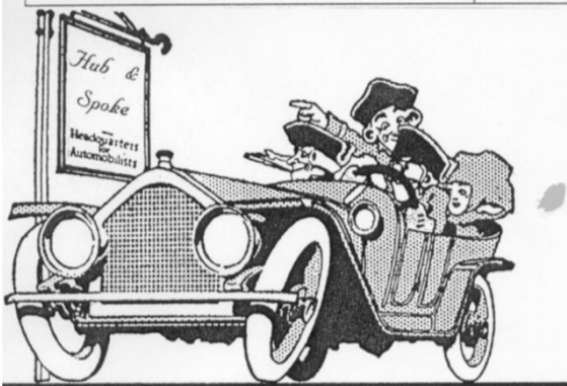

The 50/50 Drawing winner was Claude Williams.

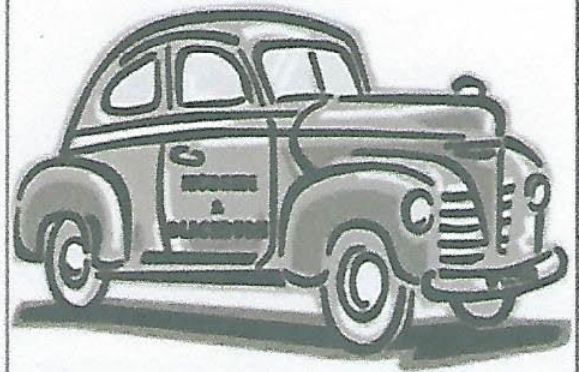
Old Business:
