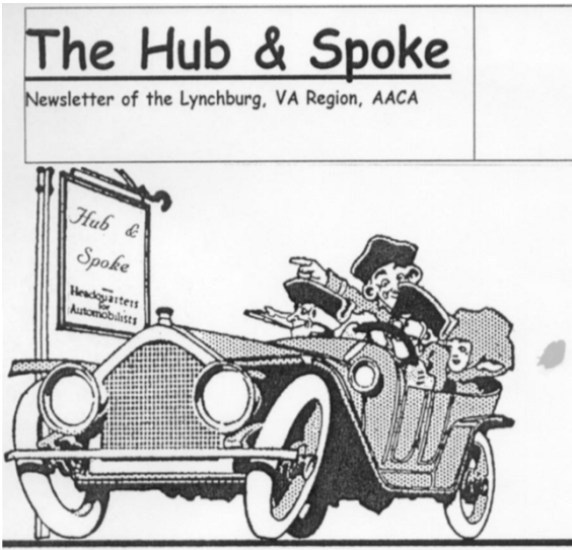




The 50/50 Drawing winner was Charles Thaxton. He donated his winnings back to the Club.
